EU Culture Portal Web site, by the European Commission. <http://europa.eu.int/comm/culture/index_en.htm>

Summary: Available in English, Spanish, German, Italian, and French, this Web site focuses on gathering information sources and summarizing action of the European Union in the field of culture and related activities (i.e., music, dance, heritage, restoration) of the member states. Information is linked under the categories: Fields of Activity, National Web Sites, Events, Europe in Action, and Funding. It is not a publishing body, but does link to many sources of information within the EU and its member states.

The European Union's action in the field of culture is defined by its founding treaty, and not by the national **cultural policies** of its member states. "With its respect for cultural diversity, the EU aims to help open up European cultures whilst at the same time enhancing the common heritage which Europeans share. EU action looks to encourage cultural cooperation and exchange amongst Europeans and to support shared knowledge of cultural production right across the board."²

Detailed Description: The category Fields of Activity explains the direction of the EU in cultural support of activities such as theater, dance, books, and digital information. The National Web Site category links to a list of the online sites of ministries of culture within the European Union member states, candidate coun-

tries, and European economic area countries. The category Europe in Action is an overview of the activities related to cultural issues and their support within the European Union, including regulations. The Funding category summarizes the research programs, services, and cooperation within the context of the theme.

European Heritage Network Web site, by the European Heritage Network. <<http://www.european-heritage.net/>>

Summary: The *European Heritage Network* Web site provides access to European national **cultural policies** and an online **cultural** portal of selected links, which is an annotated, bibliographical online resource organizing and linking researchers to online information on European countries, culture, environment, urban planning, international cooperation, communication, research, and resources. The entire Web site is available in English, Spanish, and French, and there is a site map. An online, searchable multilingual **thesaurus** of **cultural** terms is under construction.

First established in 1999, the *European Heritage Network* which grew out of the *HEREIN* project, is an intergovernmental initiative linking authorities responsible for the heritage Europe-wide and providing them with a common working tool for exploiting advanced information technology resources. The *HEREIN* Project has been through two phases, became the foundation of the **cultural** portal of the *European Heritage Network*, and is currently supported by the European Union.

Detailed Description: The national heritage **policies** are an online databank of the **cultural** heritage reports, which are required by Treaty. The information can be searched by country and theme, and nations may submit their reports online at this site. The **cultural** portal, under Selected Links, provides links to official texts, documents, databases, virtual visits, and directories of resources. It is a free, searchable online database of European countries heritage Web Sites, with searching available by country, themes, and keywords. Other information available through the *European Heritage Network* site includes news, an online forum, a **thesaurus**, FAQs, and information on the European Heritage Program, as well as on the European and International cooperation.
