“What was CPANDA?”

CPANDA, the Cultural Policy & the Arts National Data Archive, was the world's first interactive digital archive of policy-relevant data on the arts and cultural policy in the United States. It was founded in 2001. It was a collaborative effort of Princeton University's Firestone Library and the Princeton Center for Arts and Cultural Policy Studies. The Pew Charitable Trusts (<http://www.pewtrusts.org>) underwrote the original development of the archive. The National Endowment for the Arts (<http://www.arts.gov>) completed transferring all data content in January 2016. Check at ICPSR, the National Archive of Data on Arts and Culture (NADAC). The CPANDA Bibliography will remain online for now.”

“ARTICLE INDEXES

Articles in scholarly publications provide research results, analysis, statistics and position papers by academics and researchers. You can get a sense of how policies in different jurisdictions affect organizations similar to your own or search for discussion of policy issues by topic.

When searching for journal articles, consider how these provide a national and international context for your organization, as well as the local, for example, creative cultural funding sources (tax incentives), the influence of globalization and developments that influence the cultural infrastructure.

“ConnectCP: the International database of cultural policy experts

ConnectCP is the international who's who of cultural policy, planning and research. It is an online database that contains profiles of 'experts' in cultural policy. Each profile outlines an 'experts' experience, current interests, and other information relevant to their work in cultural policy.

To be considered an 'expert' for ConnectCP, a person needs to be recognised in the field of arts and cultural policy as someone who holds a senior research, policy, teaching or management position and/or has demonstrated expertise, at national and international level, in research, analysis or commentary. Experts need to be prepared to provide and update information about themselves and their work for ConnectCP, and may be asked to provide referees.

By encouraging participation in this database ConnectCP aims to stimulate the interaction of people with knowledge in the cultural policy sector, mobilise human resources, and facilitate the flow of cultural policy information.

ConnectCP is a project of IFACCA. The Boekmanstichting was also an initiating partner when ConnectCP was launched in 2006.
